### FINALS PROTOCOLS

SCORERS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>One scorer from each team must be standing together &amp; away from other spectators</li> </ul>
ELIGIBILITY	<p>Ensure that ALL players are <u>ELIGIBLE</u> – <i>read the BNA by-laws available on the website</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Players may only participate in ONE finals series ie) cannot play for 2 teams / clubs</li> <li>Players may not play in sections LOWER than the section they have qualified in during the season</li> <li>Players must have played a minimum of 5 games with the team / club to qualify</li> <li>All names must be printed on the score sheet</li> <li>Teams playing ineligible players will be considered to have LOST the match</li> </ul>
RESPECT	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>All players, coaches &amp; spectators must be respectful of their teammates, opposition, umpires &amp; administrators. Disrespectful behaviour and language will not be tolerated.</li> </ul>
UMPIRES	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Only the CAPTAIN may approach an umpire during an interval – not the coach or parents</li> <li>Umpire supervisors will be allocated to each court during the day.</li> <li>If you require the assistance of a court / umpire supervisor, please ask at the office.</li> <li>There will be no Umpire Training Program during the finals series</li> </ul>
COACHES	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Coaches MAY coach from the sidelines but may not direct play</li> </ul>
GRIEVANCES	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>If you are concerned about the behaviour of any player, coach, umpire, spectator, please ask at the office for the <u>court supervisor</u> to witness the behaviour first hand – we cannot respond to grievances based upon “biased heresay” after the match.</li> <li>Be aware of our Grievance Protocol</li> </ul>
DRAWS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>2 X 3 minute halves will be played</li> <li>Changes MAY be made at the end of the first half</li> <li>If the scores are still level play continues until one team has a 2 goal advantage (Yr 7 and over).</li> <li>For Yr 5/6, a coin will be tossed to determine the next centre pass and play continues until the next goal is scored</li> </ul>
WEATHER	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>If a finals match is cancelled after half time, the half time score will be taken as the official score</li> <li>If a finals match is cancelled before half time, the team who finished higher on the ladder will be deemed to be the winner.</li> </ul>
PRESENTATIONS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Trophy presentations will be held on court 1 at the end of each match</li> </ul>
