BOROONDARA NETBALL ASSOCIATION JUNIOR DEVELOPMENT PROGRAM

Program	School Year	Day	Description
JuniorNet G1/ 2	1/ 2	Fridays	Play-based fundamental motor skills
JuniorNet G3	3	Fridays	Netball skills clinics with modified rules & equipment
JuniorNet G4	4	Fridays	Non-competitive weekly matches, no finals, no ladders,
Saturday Netball	5	Saturday	Competitive weekly matches with ladders & finals

What happens after JuniorNet G1 /2 ?

- Each year there are 3 x JuniorNet G1/2 programs – Term 2, Term 3 and Term 4. Players may choose to participate in as many term(s) as they wish.
- Players in Prep are welcome to join the Term 4 program.

At the end of the year, players from:

- Prep / Grade 1, have the option to re-join the G1/2 program the following year.
- Year 2, will progress to the JuniorNet G3 program the next year – netball specific skills & matches.

All current participants will automatically receive registration forms for JN G3 early next year.

What happens after the JuniorNet G3 ?

- Each year there is ONE JuniorNet G3 program which runs over **Terms 2 and 3**.
- In **Term 4**, players have the option to JOIN a CLUB or create their own independent team and play matches in our Spring Fling, also on Friday afternoons.
- In **Year 4**, players must JOIN a CLUB or create their own independent team to play in our JuniorNet G4 competition.

The Term 4 Spring Fling and Year 4 programs are:

- CLUB /team-based programs meaning players must join a club or created an independent team
- Round robin, non-competitive format with no ladders and no finals. Teams play matches each week, but the prime aims remain skill development, learning the correct rules and having fun.
- No player is permitted to play **competitive** netball in this Association before Grade 5. This is in keeping with the Netball Australia Junior Development Policy.
