



BOROONDARA NETBALL ASSOCIATION SELECTION POLICY



PREPARATION

1. **PLAYER PROFILE** submissions collated and lists prepared for selectors
2. All players notified of selection policies and protocols
3. **COURT RUNS** pre-prepared by selection coordinator randomly.
Copies provided to each selector & pinned on wall for players to view
4. **COACH REPORTS available for current players:** written defining player 1) Skills / weaknesses, 2) Potential, 3) Attitude / commitment 4) Attendance / group dynamics
5. **PLAYER PROFILE SHEETS available:** submitted by players defining previous achievements etc
6. **INJURED / UNAVAILABLE PLAYERS:** To submit explanation and medical certification (where appropriate)

SELECTORS' RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Declare conflicts of interest
Parents may not be involved in any capacity in selections where their daughter are trialling.
- Complete NA "Select for Netball Success"
- Each selector writes notes on each player (see court runs sheet) and ranks 1 – 3
 - Use of selection tool, KPAs
- Selectors meet after each trial to discuss lists
- Selection panel's decision is FINAL.
Accept that the group decision may differ from individual selectors' and past coach views
- Strict adherence to Boroondara Netball Association policies and procedures
- Confidentiality: Do not discuss decisions, conversations regarding selections / players
- All queries to be in writing to the Association; no verbal discussions with players
- ALL notes and lists given to selection co-ordinator after selections for collating and for provision of player feedback where requested.
- Players may request written feedback on their individual selection performance / coach reports. This request must be in writing to the selection coordinator. The response will be a written summary of information available.

WHAT ARE WE LOOKING FOR?

1. Individual:

- Body type
- Foundation skills: ball handling, footwork, specialist skills
- Fitness: speed, change of direction, strength / power
- Mental skills: recovery from mistakes, ability to re-focus, accountable, leader / creates change, works as a member of a unit
- Decision making skills
- Intensity / work ethic

2. Team:

- Team balance: Are the best individual players the best combination within the team?
- Style of play: different styles of players so there is the option to change the style of play in a match ie) attacking vs defending midcourt; long vs close shooter, impact players
