INTRODUCING UMPIRING

All umpire forms and information have been updated on the website:

- Registration forms includes Declaration of Hobby form
- Umpire payments
- Expectations of Umpires including Code of Behaviour
- Umpire Training program / Umpire Courses & theory exam
- Boroondara Netball Association Constitution & By-Laws.

AVAILABILITY:

- Umpire Availability sheets will be forwarded once the fixtures have been finalised to those umpires who register.

ACCREDITED UMPIRES: = *Passed Theory + completed Level 1 course + completed one- on- one supervised matches.*

- Please complete an Umpire Registration form
 - If you are umpiring on behalf of a Yr 5 –9 team, you will be rostered to **umpire 1 game EVERY week.**
-you are paid at the end of each term by the Boroondara Netball Association and you save your team the Umpire Penalty Payment.
 - If you are umpiring for a Yr 10 and above team, you must be rostered to **umpire EVERY ALTERNATE WEEK** of the season for the team as per the roster which is devised from your “availability sheet”.
-you are paid by your team.
 - If you are umpiring for a Yr 4 team on Fridays, you will umpire your own team’s match using the modified Umpire Guidelines – if paid, you are paid by your team.
 - If you are umpiring for the panel, you will be rostered according to the information we receive on your availability sheets -you are paid at the end of each term by the Boroondara Netball Association.
- UMPIRE TRAINERS (job descriptions on website > Training Program)
 - Options are to train New Trainees in the morning OR Badge Trainees in the afternoon

NEW TRAINEES:

- If you have not completed your on-line Theory exam and Level 1 course, you must register to do them this year.
 - You may umpire Junior Net section (unsupervised) on Fridays in the interim.
- If you have done Theory & Level 1, you must register as a New Trainee to be rostered on with an Umpire Trainer
 - You will umpire in the mornings under supervision until your trainer advises that you are ready to umpire independently.

BADGE TRAINEES:

- If you would like to be assessed to train for a badge, you must indicate on the Rego form or discuss with our Umpire Coordinator.
 - You will be assessed and you must be available to umpire 2 afternoon matches every week with a trainer.
 - We will test umpires when trainers advise they are ready to be tested.

ALL UMPIRES:

- Must SIGN A Declaration of Hobby form before payments can be made – this is included on the Registration form
- Must complete the Umpire Availability form.
- Must check the Umpire Roster every **FRIDAY night on the website** to confirm umpiring times.
