
## **BOROONDARA EXPRESS: SUDDEN CARDIAC ARREST (SCA) PROTOCOL**

## **PRE-SEASON EDUCATION**

- Players encouraged to undergo medical review to identify any underlying conditions that may increase the risk of SCA; particularly if there is a personal history of cardiac symptoms or a family history of SCA.
- 2. All players, coaches and support staff to undergo Basic Life Support training provided by Boroondara Netball Association (BNA)
- 3. All players, coaches and support staff to be aware of the location of automated external defibrillators (AED) at all training and competition venues, and be trained in their use.

## EMERGENCY ACTION PLAN

- Designate a team member responsible for coordinating the emergency response in the event of SCA
- Immediately instruct a bystander to call emergency services (000) and retrieve the closest AED
- Immediately commence basic life support as per the Australian Resuscitation Council (ARC) flowchart
- If trained medical personnel are present, allow them to take over the emergency response
- Once Emergency Services have arrived, hand-over all relevant information and follow their instructions



## POST-EVENT

- 1. Notify the affected team member's next of kin
- 2. Notify Boroondara Netball Association officials
- 3. Boroondara Netball Association to provide support and counselling to team members
- 4. Review the response and identify any areas for improvement or additional training
